Graduated in Jan 1992 from the Royal London, he spent 2 years in dental hospitals in Paedodontics and Oral surgery in London and Essex, before spending 2 years in general dental practice in Wimbledon London. He travelled to The USA to Univ of Calif San Francisco to do a 3 year Specialty Program in Prosthodontics along with a Masters in Oral Biology. He returned to the UK and The Eastman Dental Hospital in 1999 where he helped establish the M.Clin. Dent in Prosthodontics and spent 10 years Co-ordinating the Restorative Mono-specialist trainees in there final year preparing for MRD and exit examinations for the 3 Restorative Mono Specialties.

He established Royal House Dental Centre in 2002 to present in Henley-on-Thames, Oxfordshire UK providing general and specialist restorative care particularly implant-based dentistry.

Main interests in dentistry – 3D scanning and printing, Implant complications, Education of future graduates, Treatment of the aging dentition and longevity of restorations.

## Abstract

### '30 Years in Restorative Dentistry Evolution or Revolution?'

This presentation will look back at the author's 30 years in clinical practice from dental school to 20+ years in his practice he established outside London. He will use a number of cases from the past to illustrate what has revolutionized practice and what has really evolved. Including the use of 3D Intra-oral scanning and new manufacturing techniques.

He will present a mixture of cases from single tooth to complex reconstructions. What has failed what is predictable and what isn't. Questioning perhaps where the research should be heading and what we still don't really understand.
